ORDINANCE NO. 74-92

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

> A part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, as follows: Beginning at a point 730.25 feet East and 76.35 feet North of the Southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter; thence North 77 degrees 46 minutes 20 seconds West for 111.66 feet; thence North 89 degrees 22 minutes West for 231.61 feet; thence North 56 degrees 57 minutes 12 seconds West for 72.40 feet; thence North 00 degrees 31 minutes 30 seconds East for 440.57 feet; thence South 89 degrees 21 minutes 30 seconds East for 491.24 feet; thence South 00 degrees 38 minutes West for 502.11 feet and to the point of beginning, containing 5.41 acres, more or less.

The above description describes properties where Motel 6 and McDonalds Restaurant are to be located at the Northeast corner of State Highway #37 By-Pass and State Road #48.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
