

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 74- 16

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM VARIOUS FUNDS EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budgets, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergencies, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the following Funds of said City, funds not otherwise appropriated to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year of 1974 that was set out in detail in the budgets as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:

GENERAL FUND+

FIRE DEPARTMENT

To 7 PROPERTIES
72 Equipment \$16,206

SPECIAL FUNDS

MOTOR VEHICLE HIGHWAY FUND

To 4 MATERIALS
43 Repair Parts. \$12,000

PARK DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION FUND

To Construction Costs \$60,557

SECTION II. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


