WHEREAS, the Sewage Waste Treatment and Collection System of the City of Bloomington and the regions of which it is a part is inadequate to meet the future needs of the community within the standards of the waste water treatment required by the State of Indiana and the Environmental Protection Agency of the United States, and,

WHEREAS, State and Federal assistance is available to provide the expansion necessary to meet these standards,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA that the Mayor of said City, Francis X.

McCloskey, is authorized to execute and file whaterer documents are necesary, by and on behalf of the City of Bloomington,

Indiana, to apply for assistance from the State of Indiana and the United States of America to bring about the needed expansion.
