## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 73-2

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND, EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO MEET THEEXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST IN THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the Revenue Sharing Trust Fund of said City, funds not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditures of more money for the current year of 1973, than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:
