

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 73-5

AN ORDINANCE ESPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE LOCAL ROAD AND STREET FUND OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, FUNDS NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED TO MEET THE EXTRAORDINARY EMERGENCIES FOUND TO EXIST IN SAID FUND:

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate money that was not appropriated in said annaul budget; NOW, THEREFORE, to meet such extraordinary emergency:

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, that there be and hereby is appropriated from the Local Road and Street Fund of said City, not otherwise appropriated, to meet the extraordinary emergency found to exist for the expenditure of more money for the current year 1973 than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sum:

SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
