AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF ALL ELECTED CITY OFFICIALS. 000089

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is directed by the Acts of 1933, Chapter 233, Section 20a, as amended, the same being Section 48-1233 of Burns Indiana Statutes Annotated to fix the annual salaries of all elected city officials by ordinance duly enacted on or before the first day of April of the year in which elections of city officials are held.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana;

SECTION 1. That the annual salaries of elected officials of the City of Bloomington for the term beginning January 1, 1972 and extending through December 31, 1975 shall be:

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.


