

ORDINANCE NO. 67-3

An ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the now existing corporation line at its point of intersection with the North Right-of-way line of State Highway No. 48 said point being 539.69 feet East and 40 feet North of the Southwest corner of Section 32, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana; thence West on and along said North Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 48 to a point that is 966 feet West and 40 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 36, Township 9 North, Range 2 West; Thence North 00 degrees, 57 minutes, 30 seconds West for a distance of 199.25 feet; thence North 89 degrees, 17 minutes East for a distance of 273 feet; thence North for a distance of 816.75 feet; thence South 89 degrees, 18 minutes West for a distance of 356.17 feet; thence North 01 degrees, 41 minutes West for a distance of 44 feet; thence South 89 degrees, 18 minutes, West for a distance of 396 feet; thence South 01 degrees, 41 minutes East for a distance of 1060 feet and to the North Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 48; thence West on and along said North Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 48 to a point that is due North of a point 320 feet west and 40 feet South of the Northeast corner of the West half of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana; thence South 00 degrees, 02 minutes, 35 seconds East for a distance of 527.37 feet; thence East for a distance of 118.50 feet; thence South 00 degrees, 02 minutes 35 seconds East for a distance of 1786.15 feet; thence South 89 degrees, 27 minutes, 13 seconds East for a distance of 171.5 feet; thence North 00 degrees, 02 minutes, 35 seconds West for a distance of 2275.15 feet more or less and to the South Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 48; thence East on and along said South Right-of-Way line to the point of intersection of said South Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 48 with the East Right-of-Way line of Hickory Drive in Highland Village Fourth Addition of a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana; thence South on and along said East Right-of-Way line of Hickory Drive for a distance of 200 feet; thence East for a distance of 108.2 feet; thence North for a distance of 200 feet and to the South Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 48; thence East on and along said South Right-of-Way line to a point that is 885 feet East and 40 feet South of the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 2 West; thence South for a distance of 100 feet; thence East for a distance of 100 feet; thence North for a distance of 100 feet and to the South Right-of-Way line of State Highway No. 48; thence East on and along said South Right-of-Way line to the now existing corporation line; thence North on and along said corporation line to the point of beginning.


Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate herein above described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.


