An ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-INGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the city of Bloom-ington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Block A, Highland Village Fourth Addition and a part of the North half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana, Bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point that is 904 feet west and 40 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Quarter Section; thence West 416.6 feet; thence South 441.5 feet; thence North 89 degrees 11 minutes East 174.01 feet; thence North 0 degrees 2 minutes West 130 feet; thence North 89 degrees 11 minutes East 242.99 feet; thence North 0 degrees 2 minutes West 305.3 feet and to the point of beginning.

Also lots numbered 146, 145, 144 and 8.49 feet off the entire West side of 143, all in Highland Village Fourth Addition of a part of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana.

Section 2. BE IT FUTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate herein above described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, publication and approval by the Mayor.
