

ORDINANCE NO. 67-20

An ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous Territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:


Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Highland Village 10th Addition, being a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 8 North, Range 2 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows: Beginning at a point 824.91 feet East and 497.15 feet South of the Northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter, Thence South 00 degrees 02 minutes 35 seconds East for 1520.27 feet, thence North 89 degrees 27 minutes 15 seconds West for 121.50 feet, thence South 00 degrees 02 minutes 35 seconds East for 101.82 feet, thence North 88 degrees 29 minutes 35 seconds West for 155.50 feet, thence South 00 degrees 02 minutes 35 seconds for 161.47 feet, thence South 89 degrees 27 minutes 15 seconds East for 569.93 feet, thence North 00 degrees 02 minutes 35 seconds West for 1765.41 feet, thence North 89 degrees 27 minutes 15 seconds West for 293.00 feet and to the point of beginning. Containing in all 12.85 acres more or less.


Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate herein above described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, publication and approval by the Mayor.
