

Ordinance No. 67-40

An Ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Description for the proposed annexation of the land owned by Robert and Victoria Weber.

A part of the Northwest quarter of Section 11, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe County, Indiana, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point that is 1106.61 feet East of the Northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter; thence South 1 degree 21 minutes 30 seconds East for 564.24 feet; thence South 88 degrees 44 minutes 30 seconds East for a distance of 193.0 feet more or less and to a point that is 564.2 feet South of the Northeast corner of the West half of said Northwest Quarter Section; thence North 564.2 feet and to the Northeast corner of said East half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11; thence West 193 feet more or less and to the point of beginning.

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be and the same are hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, publication and approval by the Mayor.
