

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 67-1

An ordinance specially appropriating from the General Funds not otherwise appropriated of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, and reduction of funds theretofore appropriated for the use of Departments of said City, to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist in the various departments:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the General Funds of said City, not otherwise appropriated to meet the extraordinary emergencies found to exist for the expenditures of more money for the current year of 1967, than was set out in detail in the budget as finally adopted, and appropriations as finally made, the following sums:


