ORDINANCE NO. 66-24, 1966

An Ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to wit:

A part of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said quarter quarter and running over and along the center line of the public highway, formerly known as the Matlock Road, and now known as Bloomington By-Pass or Indiana State Highway No. 146, for a distance of 368.5 feet; thence South 300 feet; thence West 150 feet; thence South 250 feet, and to the South line of the property conveyed by Clara A. Dickson and William R. Dickson, her husband, to Ernest Biermann, by deed dated March 12, 1912, and recorded on page 544 of Deed Record 58 of the records of the County Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana; thence East on said South line for a distance of 518.5 feet, and to the East boundary of said quarter quarter; thence North on said East boundary line a distance of 550 feet, more or less, and to the point of beginning. containing 4.6 acres, more or less.

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are hereby, declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate herein above described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
