

ORDINANCE NO. 66-28

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SEPARATE BOARD OF
PUBLIC WORKS AND A BOARD OF PUBLIC SAFETY

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington:

Section 1. There is hereby created a separate board to be known as the "Board of Public Works," which board shall consist of three (3) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor to serve at his pleasure. All such members shall be required to be legal residents and freeholders of the City of Bloomington and may be persons who hold other elective or appointive positions within such City. Each member of such board shall receive for his services compensation in an amount to be fixed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Common Council. No such member who holds any other remunerative position with the City shall be entitled to receive additional compensation for services performed as a member of such board.

Section 2. There is hereby created a separate board to be known as the "Board of Public Safety," which board shall consist of three (3) members who shall be appointed by the Mayor to serve at his pleasure. All such members shall be required to be legal residents and freeholders of the City of Bloomington and may be persons who hold other elective or appointive positions within such City. Each member of such board shall receive for his services compensation in an amount to be fixed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Common Council. No such member who holds any other remunerative position with the City shall be entitled to receive additional compensation for services performed as a member of such board.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, and publication in accordance with the law.
