## ORDINANCE NO. 66-57

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-INGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Lot number Four (4) in BARCLAY GARDENS, being a subdivision of the West one-half of the Northeast Quarter; and part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; and part of the East one-half of the Northeast Quarter; and part of the North one-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 9, Township 8 North, Range 1 West.

Section 2. BE IF FURTHER ORDAINED, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are hereby, declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate herein above described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
