ORDINANCE NO. 65-1

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of the Sotheast quarter of Section 34, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Southeast quarter, running thence West on the South line thereof 62 feet; thence running North 118.5 feet, thence running east 4 feet, thence running West 4 feet, thence running North 18 feet and 3 inches, thence running East 62 feet, thence running South 180 feet and to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
