

ORDINANCE NO. 64-28

An Ordinance Concerning the Annexation of  
Adjacent and Contiguous Territory

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the West improvement line of North College Avenue, which point is 770.7 feet North and 827.5 feet East of the Southwest corner of Section 28, Township 9 North, Range 1 West, and running thence North over and along the West improvement line of North College Avenue to a point that is 1294.7 feet North and 812.5 feet East of said Southwest corner and on the West improvement line of North College Avenue, running thence South 87 degrees 0.8 minutes West for a distance of 556 feet, and running thence South to a point directly West of the point of beginning, and running thence East 556 feet more or less and to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
