

ORDINANCE NO. 64-33, 1964

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 5-11 ENTITLED "DOGS".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 11 of Chapter 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

"No owner or keeper of any dog shall permit such dog to run at large or upon the premises of one other than the owner and such act is declared to be a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding ten (10) days, or both."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
