

ORDINANCE NO. 64-34, 1964

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 17 ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" BY AMENDING SECTION 180 ENTITLED "BICYCLE LICENSES - ISSUANCE GENERALLY "; AND SECTION 188 ENTITLED "BICYCLE LICENSE - FEE".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 180 of Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

"The Clerk-Treasurer upon receiving proper application therefor is authorized to issue a bicycle license which shall be effective until the second succeeding first day of January."

SECTION 2. That Section 188 of Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

"Before any person shall operate a bicycle upon the city streets, he shall first obtain a license so to do from the Clerk-Treasurer or his agents for which license he shall pay a fee of twenty cents."

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
