## ORDINANCEFOF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON HOUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. <u>6</u>, 1963

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, by amending Chapter 5 entitled "Animals and Foul", Section 10 thereof entitled "Running at large - Vicious, etc.; females in heat; impounding; killing when nesessary" and Section 11 thereoffentitled "Unlicensed dogs."

BE IT ORDAINED BY : THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 10 of Chapter 5, entitled "Running at large - Vicious, etc.; females in heat; impounding; killing when necessary" be amended to read as follows:

No dog shall be allowed to run at large or upon the premiees of one other than the owner. If any such dog is found running at large in violation of this provision, it shall be taken up and impounded and shall be released only after payment of the fees provided in section 5-15 of this Code; provided, however, that if any dangerous, fierce or vicious dog so found at large cannot be safely taken up and impounded, such dog may be slain by any policeman or humane officer or assistant.

SECTION 2. That Section 11 of Chapter 5, entitled "Unlicensed dogs" be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 5-11. Owner's Responsibility.

No owner or keeper of any dog shall permit such dog to run at large.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
