ORDINANCE NO. <u>8</u>, 1963

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAP, DATED JULY 18, 1950

WHEREAS, The Common Conncil of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance amd map became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has recommended that said Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain properties, now

> THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMONNCOUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 174, ACTS OF 1947, OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to rezone the following described land in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, from its present R-1 ONE FAMILY ZONE classification to an R-3 MULTIPLE DWELLING ZONE, to-wit?

> The area bounded on the North by Kenwood Drive; bounded on the West by Madison Street; bounded on the South by Fifthenth Street; and bounded on the east by the first north and south alley West of Woodburn Avenue.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be inffull force and effect from and after its passage and approval by ;the Mayor.
