An Ordinance concerning the annexation of adjacent and contiguous territory pursuant to the filing of voluntary petitions for annexation.

WHEREAS, the boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, is along and adjacent to the real estate described herein, and

WHEREAS, the owners of the lands hereinafter described have submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, a petition for and on their behalf for annexation of certain territory of which the petitioners are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana; to-wit:

A part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Twentyeight (28), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West, in Monroe County, Indiana, bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the point of inter-section of the North line of Miller Courts Addition with the East line of State Highway Number Thirtyseven (37) North bound, said point being on the now existing corporation line; thence East on and along the North line of Miller Courts Addition to the Northwest corner of Lot Number One Hundred Thirty-eight (138) in said addition; thence South on and along the West line of said Lot Number One Hundred Thirty-eight (138) to the Southwest corner thereof; thence East on and along the North line of Twentieth (20th) Street to the Southeast corner of Lot Number One Hundred Twentyeight (128); thence North on and along the East line of said Lot Number One Hundred Twenty-eight (128) to the Northeast corner thereof; thence East on and along the North line of Miller Courts Addition to the East line of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West; thence North Nine hundred Fifty-five and Five-tenths (955.5) feet and to the North line of the Lee Leonard real estate; thence West Seven hundred Ninety-(790) feet and to the East line of the Charles B. Myers real estate; thence South Four hundred Forty and Five-tenths (440.5) feet and to the South line of the said Charles B. Myers real estate; thence West to the East line of State High-way Number Thirty-seven (37) Northbound and the existing corporation line; thence Southeasterly on and along the existing corporation line to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. ThisOrdinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957.

BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

Article II, Chapter 5, Section 5-18 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 5-18. Disposition of suspect having bitten a person. If a dog has bitten a person, such dog shall be impounded in the City pound or veterinary hospital, or confined by a leash or chain on the owner's premises and placed under observation for a period of two weeks, at the expense of the owner. If the dog in question dies within the observation period of two weeks, the dog shall, at the expense of the owner, be sent to the state board of health for examination for rabies. (Ord. No. 17, 1956, \$ 12.)"

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
