

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON
COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 20, 1962

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana 1957, by amending Chapter 18 thereof entitled "Offenses - Miscellaneous" by adding Section 18-43 thereto.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

That a new Section 43 of Chapter 18 be adopted as follows:

Section 18-43. Intoxicating Beverages - Consumption in Publicly Owned Places.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person within the city limits, whether within, on or outside of a motor vehicle of any type, to consume any alcoholic beverage in or on any publicly owned place, or upon any public street, highway or accessway.
- (b) Any person violating any provision of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months or both.
- (c) This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and shall be construed as supplementary to and in amplification of existing state laws providing for regulation and control of the sale or consumption of intoxicating liquors. (Ind. Ann. Stat. §§ 12-301 et seq.)
