ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. <u>10</u>, 1961

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE "MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, 1957", BY AMENDING CHAPTER 30, ARTICLE III, SECTION 30-26 WITH RESPECT TO PERMITTED USES IN A B-1 ZONE.

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a Zoning Ordinance on July 18, 1950, which said Ordinance became effective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Ordinance is now incorporated in the "Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957", as Chapter 30 of said code, and

WHEREAS, The City Plan Commission has recommended that Section 26, Sub-section 2 of Chapter 30 be amended by the addition of a sub-section 2 (x) to permit the use of customer operated cleaning equipment ina B-1 Zone, now

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 174, ACTS OF 1947, OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the "Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957; be amended by the addition of Sub-section 2 (x) following 2 (w) in Section 30-26, as follows:

2.

(x) Cleaning establishment limited to the use of customer operated cleaning equipment.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
