An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957.

BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

Article 3, Chapter 23, Section 23-30 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, be amended to read as follows:

"Section 23-30. Application required. Any property owner of the City of Bloomington residing in an area zoned for residential purposes may apply to the Clerk-Treasurer of the city for a permit for one parking space adjacent to such residential property. 'Adjacent' shall also mean directly across the street in case no space is available on the side of the street adjacent to the owner's property."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
