

ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1958

An Ordinance Adopting a Revision and Codification of the Ordinances of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the ordinances of the City of Bloomington of a general and permanent nature, as revised, amended, restated, codified and recodified in the following chapters, namely Chapters 1 to 30, both inclusive, are ordained as general ordinances and are adopted as "Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957".

SECTION 2. That this Municipal Code shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law and the filing thereof in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer.
