ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA Ordinance No. <u>10</u> 1958

An Ordinance Authorizing the Investment of Funds in United States Government Bonds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to invest monies from the various funds of the City or any department thereof in Unived States Government Bonds as such monies become available for such investment from time to time, but provided however that such investments and the monies derived therefrom shall in each instance be in accordance with Section 1, Chapter 9, of the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana for the year 1945.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
