An Ordinance authorizing borrowing of money for a temporary period to pay installment of land purchase contract.

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington has purchased land for the purpose of establishing a cemetery, and

WHEREAS, the purchase of said lands has been occasioned by reason of the present cemetery approaching capacity, and

WHEREAS, it is commutemplated that the payment for said a lands will be made out of the sale of lots in said cemetery when developed, and

WHEREAS, the development thereof has not been completed within time to realize sufficient income to meet the first installment of said land contract,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Bloomington, through its Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer be hereby authorized to borrow the sum of Six Thousand Two Mundred and Forty-two Bollars (\$6,242.00) from The Monroe County State Bank for a period of six months with interest at the rate of four percent (4%) per annum.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the City, through its Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer, execute to the Monroe County State Bank, its promissory note in the sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred Forty-two Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$6,242.20) payable six months from date providing for attorney's fees and interest at the rate of four percent (4%) per annum and that the City pledge the income from said lands for the payment of said note.
