

ORDINANCE NO. 20, 1958

An Ordinance amending an Ordinance relating to and regulating traffic in certain congested areas in the City of Bloomington, State of Indiana, defining and regulating the parking of vehicles in certain areas of the City of Bloomington; providing for the designation of separate parking spaces, for the use of such parking spaces, and for the use of mechanical parking time indicators in conjunction therewith, and providing for penalties for violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 3, 1948 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Regulation of Parking in Individual Parking Spaces. Whenever a vehicle shall be parked in a separate parking space where a parking meter has been installed, the person parking such vehicle shall deposit coins of the United States, if such meter displays the signal showing that legal parking is only permitted on such deposit as follows:

Five cents (5%) for each thirty (30) minute period, or
Five cents (5%) for each sixty (60) minute period, or longer.

Notice to the public shall be given by appropriate signs setting forth the length of time for which parking is permitted and the conditions thereof. These may be on the parking meter stand or in the immediate vicinity. Any vehicle which remains in a separate parking space after the time has elapsed for which the privilege of parking in said space has been paid is hereby determined to be illegally parked.

The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to vehicles parked or standing upon the streets of the City of Bloomington in the congested areas hereinbefore described from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 6:00 o'clock P.M. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Saturdays of each week, and from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 9:00 o'clock P.M. on Fridays of each week all times herein be legal time of the State of Indiana.

The meters for parking motor vehicles as herein provided on the streets of the City of Bloomington, surrounding the square, and one block each way therefrom, and on Indiana Avenue between Fourth and Fifth Street, shall be five cents (5%) for each one-half hour; all other meter charges shall be five cents (5%) for each hour.

The provisions of this ordinance as to the payment for parking privileges shall not apply on Sundays and legal holidays.

This amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and the approval of the Mayor of the City of Bloomington.
