ORDINANCE NO. <u>- 16</u>,1957

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAP. DATED JULY 18. 1950.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a zoning ordinance and adopted a zoning map on July 18, 1950, which said ordinance and map becameeffective on November 17, 1950, and

WHEREAS, The City Plan Commission has recommended that the Bloomington Zoning Map be amended by the rezoning of certain property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the Map entitled "Bloomington Zoning Map", dated July 18, 1950, be amended to rezone all of that part of Lot No. 101, Watermans Addition in the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, that is not now in a B3 zone from its present R1 ONE_FAMILTY ZONE classifacation to a B3 GENERAL BUSINESS ZONE.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
