An Ordinance relating to the renaming of a city street.

WHEREAS, Lone Star Addition to the City of Bloomington was platted in 1928, and

WKEREAS, the street along the south edge of said plat was at that time named Diamond Streef, and

WHEREAS, said Street is still so named on the official maps in the City Engineer's office, and

WHEREAS, said Street is approximately in line with and is commonly referred to as Tenth Street,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Diamond Street in the Lone Star Addition shall be and is hereby now renamed West Tenth Street.

SECTION 2. That the City Engineer shall correct the official city maps to reflect this change of name.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
