

## ORDINANCE NO. 16, 1953

An Ordinance Concerning the Annexation of  
Adjacent and Contiguous Territory Pursuant  
to the Filing of a Voluntary Petition for  
Annexation.

WHEREAS, the Eastern boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, North of Hillsdale First Addition, is along the East line of Highland Homes Addition, and

WHEREAS, the South boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, East of Highland Homes Addition, is along the North line of Hillsdale First Addition to the City of Bloomington, and

WHEREAS, HARRY STEPHENS, Jr., VIRGINIA STEPHENS, HERMAN DECKARD, DOROTHY DECKARD, ROBERT KINSER and EVA KINSER have submitted to the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, their Petition for Annexation of certain territory of which they are the owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to, and declared a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana:

A part of the East half of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty-Four (34) Township Nine (9) North, Range One (1) West, beginning at a point that is One Thousand Ninety-Six and fifteen hundredths (1096.15) feet North of the Southwest corner of the East half of the said Southeast Quarter, said point being the Northwest corner of Lot No. Sixty-Two (62) in Hillsdale First Addition to the City of Bloomington, Indiana; running thence in a Northerly direction over and along the East line of the Highland Homes Addition to the City of Bloomington, Indiana for a distance of One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight (1388) feet and to the South right of way line of the Illinois Central Railroad. Thence, running South Seventy-Eight (78) degrees and Thirty (30) Minutes East over and along the said South right of way line of said Railroad for a distance of One Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Four and one-tenth (1354.1) feet; thence running South for a distance of One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight (1388) feet and to the North line of the said Hillsdale First Addition. Thence running over and along the North line of the said Hillsdale First Addition the following courses and distances: South Eighty-seven (87) degrees and Thirty (30) minutes West for a distance of Five Hundred Twenty (520) feet, North Fifty-Six (56) degrees West for a distance of Sixty-Seven (67) feet; North Fifty-Nine (59) degrees West for a distance of Seventy four and one-tenth (74.1) feet, North Sixty-Three (63) degrees West for a distance of Two Hundred Four (204) feet, North Eighty-Three (83) feet, South Eighty-Seven (87) degrees West for a distance of One Hundred Ninety (190) feet, North Eighty-Eight (88) degrees West for a distance of Three Hundred Twenty-Two (322) feet and to the place of beginning. Containing in all forty (40) acres, more or less.

Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described, as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana; which said real estate has been platted in an Addition to be designated as "Green Acres Addition" to the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication, in accordance with the law.
