## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE # 3, 1950

An Ordinance of the City of Bloomington appropriating the sum of Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000.00) to be applied on the cost of construction of an addition to the fire department building, and expenses incidental thereto and the issuance of bonds on account thereof

WHEREAS, theBoard of Public Works and Safety has requested an appropriation in the amount of Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000.00) to be applied on the cost of construction of an addition to the fire department building in said City, including the incidental expenses necessary to be incurred in connection with such project and the issuance of bonds to procure the necessary funds therefor; and

WHEREAS, the Council has found that it is necessary to provide for the construction of said addition to the fire department building as requested by the Board of Public Works and Safety; that the City has no funds available for such project and it will be necessary to authorize the issuance of bonds therefor; and

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by owners of taxable real estate in the City requesting the Common Council to authorize the issuance of bonds of the City in an amount not exceeding Twentyseven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000.00) for the purpose of procuring funds to be applied on the cost of construction of an addition to the fire department building, which petition the Council has found to be in due form, properly verified by signers thereof, and certified by the Auditor of Monroe County as being sibned by more than fifty owners of taxable real estate in the City of Bloomington; that said petition in all ways conforms to the requirements of the provisions of Chapter 119 of the Acts of 1937, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Council now finds that an extraordinary emergency exists for the making of the additional appropriation requested by the Board of Public Works and Safety; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the sum of Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated for application on the cost of construction of an addition to the fire department building and for the payment of incidental expenses necessary to be incurred in connection with said project and the issuance of bonds on account thereof, as requested by the Board of Public Works and Safety. Funds to meet said appropriation shall be provided out of the proceeds of the bonds designated as "Municipal Bonds of 1950" heretofore authorized to be issued.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor
