TO AMEND <u>ORDINANCE 17-37</u>, WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS, NON-UNION, AND A.F.S.C.M.E EMPLOYEES FOR ALL THE DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA FOR THE YEAR 2018

- Re: Adjusting the Non-Union Salary Ranges Set Forth in Section 2.A. as the Result of Recommendations from a Salary and Benefits Study

WHEREAS, findings from the salary and benefits survey, conducted by a compensation consulting firm for the City of Bloomington, necessitate changes to the non-union pay grade salary ranges for 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Bloomington Common Council believe it is in the best interest of the City to amend the non-union salary ranges set forth in <u>Ordinance 17-37</u> to bring them closer to market as identified in the salary and benefits survey;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 17-37, which fixed salaries of appointed officers, non-union, and A.F.S.C.M.E employees for all the departments of the City of Bloomington for the year 2018, shall be amended by deleting the table in Section 2 A with the heading "Non-Union" and replacing it with the following table:

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance amends <u>Ordinance 17-37</u>, which fixed the salaries of appointed officers, non-union, and A.F.S.C.M.E employees for all the departments of the City for the year 2018. The amendment adjusts the non-union salary ranges set forth in Section 2.A. of the ordinance as the result of recommendations from a salary and benefits study that began early this year. This is one of the formal steps to be taken as part of a review and adjustment of salaries for non-union positions in 2018 and beyond.
