

ORDINANCE 19-27

AMENDING ORDINANCE 18-17 WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES OF OFFICERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS FOR THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON FOR 2019

- Re: Providing a One-time, \$1,000 Bonus for Officers First Class and Senior Police Officers and Adding Fire Logistics Officer

WHEREAS, as part of a new, four-year collective bargaining agreement with the City, the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP), Don Owens Memorial Lodge 88, negotiated a one-time, \$1,000 bonus payment to be paid to members during the final December 2019 payroll cycle, and takes the place of a salary increase in 2019; and

WHEREAS, as a result of changes in Ordinance 19-20, which fixed the salaries of officers in the Police and Fire departments, a logistics officer in the Fire Department was moved from that ordinance to this ordinance;

NOW BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section IA of Ordinance 18-17 shall be amended by adding the following position and maximum salary to the Fire Department Administration Table:

FIRE DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATION

SECTION 2. Section II of Ordinance 18-17 shall be amended by adding Section II E, which shall read as follows:

SECTION II E. One-time Bonus. All Senior Police Officers and Officers First Class who were employed during 2019 shall receive a \$1,000 bonus payment during the final December 2019 payroll cycle, which shall take the place of any salary increase in 2019.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
