ORDINANCE 03-26

TO AMEND CHAPTER 2.23 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE
ENTITLED "COMMUNITY AND FAMILY RESOURCES DEPARTMENT" IN ORDER
TO REAUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF BLACK MALES

WHEREAS, Ordinance 01-03 created and established the Bloomington Commission on the Status of Black Males; and

WHEREAS, a provision of that ordinance called for the Commission to be reviewed every three years for the desirability of reauthorization; and

WHEREAS, as a result of such a review by the Commission and the administration, it has been deemed desirable to reauthorize the Commission on the Status of Black Males for another three years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:


SECTION I. Bloomington Municipal Code 2.23.070(7) shall be amended by deleting it and replacing it with the following:

(7) Sunset provision. This commission shall cease to be in existence after the 31st day of January, 2007. The Commission may be renewed or reestablished by ordinance for up to three additional years at any point after January 1, 2006. Such a renewing or reestablishing ordinance shall modify the dates of this subsection of the Bloomington Municipal Code to reflect the renewal or reestablishment. Subsequently renewed or reestablished Commissions may then also be renewed or reestablished through the same process. However, if an ordinance to renew or reestablish the Commission has not been adopted by December 31, 2006, then the City Clerk shall take steps to remove this section from the Bloomington Municipal Code at the first opportunity that arises in the ordinary course of business.


SECTION II. If any sections, sentence or provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.


