

ORDINANCE 00-14

**TO AMEND ORDINANCE 99-28
WHICH FIXED THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF
THE UTILITIES DEPARTMENT FOR THE YEAR 2000
(Adding Three and Upgrading Two Positions)**

WHEREAS, the Utilities Department seeks to add three additional positions: a Regular Part Time Laborer I, a T&D Engineering Field Technician, and an Engineering Technician/Data Coordinator all funded through the department's temporary salaries budget and savings from current openings in the department; and

WHEREAS, the Job Evaluation Committee has reviewed the amended job description for two Engineering Field Specialist in the Utilities Department and has recommended changes in the title and grade for these positions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 99-28 shall be amended by changing the number of employees for the following job titles, as indicated below:

<u>Department</u>	<u>Job Title</u>	<u>Grade</u>	<u>Maximum</u>
General	Laborer I (3)	102	\$13.01
Transmission & Distribution	Engineering Field Technician (3)	5	\$39,481

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance 99-27 shall be amended by deleting the following job title, grade, and pay maximum as indicated below:

General	Engineering Field Specialists (2)	5	\$43,566


SECTION 3. Section 1 of Ordinance 99-27 shall be amended by adding the following job titles, grades, and pay maximums as indicated below:

General	Environmental Field Technician	6	\$42,420
General	Environmental Research Technician	6	\$42,420
General	Engineering Technician/Data Coordinator	4	\$31,053



SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval of the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS
