

ORDINANCE 86-41

SALARY ORDINANCE FOR POLICE AND FIRE OFFICERS

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF OFFICERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS FOR THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, FOR THE YEAR 1987.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That from and after the first day of January, 1987, pursuant to I.C. 18-1-111-1, the salary and pay schedule for the officers of the Fire Department of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, be fixed as follows, to-wit:

Salaried employees working on the afternoon shift shall receive \$11.00/week shift premium.


Salaried employees working on the night shift shall receive \$13.00/week premium.

Unscheduled Duty Pay \$14.00/hour with a one hour minimum


SECTION III. The rates shown as wages and salaries for the positions listed above are maximum rates.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




