

ORDINANCE 78-54

Salary Ordinance for Elected and Appointed Officers and Employees
of City Clerk and Court for 1979

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-
INGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the first day of January, 1979, the
salary and pay schedule for the following elected and appointed officers
and employees of the City of Bloomington, be fixed as follows:

I, the undersigned, Karel Brown Dolnick, City Clerk of the City of


SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from

State statute requires that the City Clerk submit to the Council for passage prior to August 1 of each year, an ordinance setting the rates of pay for the employees of her office and of City Court.
