SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED EMPLOYEE

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICER AND EMPLOYEES  
OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That from and after the first day of July, 1975,  
the salary and pay schedule for the following appointed employee of  
the City of Bloomington be fixed as follows:

TO THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

I, the undersigned, Francis X. McCloskey, Mayor of the City  
of Bloomington, Indiana, as required by Chapter 107 of the Acts of  
1959, hereby fix the salary and pay schedule for the following appointed  
employee of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, beginning July 1, 1975,  
and continuing thereafter until duly changed, and request that such  
salary rate be approved by the Common Council of said City, to-wit:

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
from and after its passage by the Common Council and approved by  
the Mayor.


