AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF AN APPOINTED OFFICER AND
EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA FOR THE YEAR 1975

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION I. That from and after the first day of October, 1975, the salary and pay schedule of the following appointed employee of the City of Bloomington be fixed as follows:



SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor.




