AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND
EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA FOR THE YEAR 1975

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
INDIANA

SECTION I. That from and after the first day of December, 1975,
the salary and pay schedule of the following appointed employees
of the City of Bloomington be fixed as follows:

TO THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

I the undersigned, Francis X. McCloskey, Mayor of the City
of Bloomington Indiana, as required by Chapter 107 of the Acts
of 1959, hereby fix the salary and pay schedule for the following
appointed employees of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, beginning
October 1, 1975 and continuing thereafter until duly changed and
request that such salary rates be approved by the Common Council
of said city, to-wit:

DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES

Residential Center for Recovering Alcoholics: Resident Manager
\$8,500

Assistant Manager (part-time) \$1,560

Cook/Housekeeper \$6,240

SECTION II. The rates shown as the salary for the positions
listed above is the maximum rate.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage by the Common Council and approved
by the Mayor.
