

RESOLUTION NO. 74-47

WHEREAS, a recent site plan submitted to the Plan Commission for approval has demonstrated an omission in the current zoning ordinance, and

WHEREAS, this omission concerns the matter of parking lots and the zones in which they are permissible, and

WHEREAS, the single family residential (RS) zone is an inappropriate one in which to locate parking lots,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA:

that the Common Council requests that the Plan Commission review this matter of the location of parking lots bearing in mind the Common Council's belief that parking lots are inappropriate in a RS zone and prepare amendments to the zoning ordinance which will correct this omission.
