

RESOLUTION NO.73-21, 1973

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, REGARDING THE ZONING PROCEDURES FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT AREAS THROUGHOUT THE CITY.

WHEREAS, zoning maps for the City of Bloomington should reflect land use conditions, and

WHEREAS, the same map should reflect future plans for the community, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Redevelopment and the P.A.C. are preparing development plans for project areas and redevelopment plans could reflect land use changes in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF CHAPTER 174 OF THE 1947 ACTS, OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF INDIANA.

SECTION I. That upon completion and approval of any redevelopment plan the Planning Commission shall immediately review all zoning maps in the project area and forward recommendations to the Common Council concerning any changes in zone which may be required to implement the redevelopment plan, and

SECTION 2. That the Common Council shall review said Planning Commission recommendations and act upon such recommendations at its first regularly scheduled meeting after receipt of the report of the Planning Commission.
