

ORDINANCE 66-25

AMENDED SALARY ORDINANCE FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 65-16 FIXING SALARIES OF APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, FOR THE REMAINING SEVEN (7) MONTHS OF 1966.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That from and after the first day of June, 1966, there be added to the salary and pay schedule for appointed officers and employees of Bloomington, Indiana, the following officers and employees and that the salary and pay schedule of such officers and employees be fixed as follows:

- 1. City Clerk \$5,500.00/yr.
- 2. Deputy City Treasurer \$4,800.00/yr.
- 3. City Controller
 - City Controller Budget \$5,500.00
 - Water Department 2,000.00
 - Sanitation Department 1,500.00
- 4. Administrative Asst. to the Mayor \$9,000.00/yr.
\$4,800.00/yr.

SECTION 2. That from and after the first day of June, 1966, there be removed from the salary and pay schedule of elected officers of Bloomington, Indiana, the office of Clerk-Treasurer and that the salary and pay schedule for such officer be reduced by the amount of \$7,500.00 per year.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and promulgation in accordance with the law.
