

## ORDINANCE No. 30, 1953

An Ordinance Fixing the Salaries of the Members of the School Board of the Bloomington Metropolitan Schools, as Required by Chapter 123 of the Acts of 1947, as Amended, and Found in Burns Indiana Statutes, Title 28-5906

WHEREAS, by referendum vote, the schools of the City of Bloomington were merged with the schools of Bloomington and Perry Townships in Monroe County, Indiana, under Chapter 123 of the Acts of 1947, as amended, and

WHEREAS, the State law requires the Common Council of the City of Bloomington to fix the salaries of the members of the Board of the Bloomington Metropolitan Schools.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the salaries of the members of the School Board of the Bloomington Metropolitan Schools, other than the Township Trustees, effective for the school year commencing August 1st, 1953, and terminating July 31st, 1954; and for each successive school year thereafter, shall be the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars per annum for each member of said Board.
