## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 00-01

## TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED

(Using Build Indiana Funds for Improvements to Central Dispatch Communications Systems)

WHEREAS, all the fire departments located within Monroe County have agreed to implement a new system of communications with the Emergency Dispatch Center; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington and the Perry-Clear Creek Fire Protection District each have their own frequencies; and

WHEREAS, the Ellettsville Fire Department has a frequency they share with all other fire departments in the county; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Dispatch Center must switch frequencies in order to communicate with the different fire departments in the county; and

WHEREAS, the City has applied for and received a \$50,000 grant from the Build Indiana Fund for the Unified Dispatch Signal Enhancement project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:
