

**APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 00-06**

**TO SPECIALLY APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND AND THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS NON-REVERTING FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED  
(To Transfer Monies Within the HAND Department's General Fund Budget and To Appropriate Monies from the Telecommunications Non-Reverting Fund for Community Access Television Services)**

WHEREAS, the City has determined the need to reallocate previously budgeted expenditures in the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, in particular, the City desires to procure temporary clerical services for the Housing and Neighborhood Development Department, which will require the transfer of funds from Salaries and Wages (Line 111) to Other Services and Charges (Line 399); and

WHEREAS, the City is obligated by contract to pay the Monroe County Public Library with funds from the Telecommunications Non-reverting Fund for Community Access Television Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. For the expenses of said municipal corporation, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart from the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:


SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington and approval by the Mayor.






