

ORDINANCE 98-06

TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" (Regarding Stop and Yield Intersections; Limited, Angle, and No Parking Zones; Loading Zones; and, Handicapped Parking Spaces)

WHEREAS, the Traffic Commission has recommended certain changes be made in Title 15 of Bloomington Municipal Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.12.010 Schedule A shall be amended to delete the following:

STOP INTERSECTIONS

Traffic on Sixth Street Shall Stop for Traffic On Dunn Street

SECTION II. Section 15.12.010 Schedule B shall be amended to add the following:

MULTI-STOP INTERSECTIONS

Sixth Street & Dunn Street All-Way

SECTION III. Section 15.12.020 Schedule C shall be amended to add the following:

YIELD INTERSECTIONS

Traffic on Buffstone Court Greystone Court Pinestone Court Shall Yield to Traffic on Thornton Road Thornton Road Thornton Road

SECTION IV. Section 15.32.030 Schedule L shall be amended to add the following:

ANGLE PARKING

Table with 4 columns: Street, From, To, Side of Street. Row 1: Lincoln Street, Smith Avenue, 130' South of Third Street, West

SECTION V. Section 15.32.080 Schedule M shall be amended to add the following:

NO PARKING ZONES

Table with 5 columns: Street, From, To, Side of Street, Time of Restriction. Rows include Fifth Street (Kirkwood Ave) and Union Street with various restrictions.

SECTION VI. Section 15.32.090 Schedule N shall be amended to delete the following:

LIMITED PARKING ZONES

SECTION VII. Section 15.32.090 Schedule N shall be amended to add the following:

LIMITED PARKING ZONES

| Lincoln Street | Smith Avenue | 130' South of Third Street | West | 2 Hr. (2) |

SECTION VIII. Section 15.32.100 Schedule Q shall be amended to delete the following:

LOADING ZONES

400 Block of Kirkwood, first space west of the north-south alley on the north side (between Grant and Dunn).

SECTION IX. Section 15.32.100 Schedule Q shall be amended to add the following:

LOADING ZONES

429 E. Fifth Street (Kirkwood Avenue), first space west of Dunn Street on the north side.

SECTION X. Section 15.32.120 Schedule R shall be amended to add the following:

OFFICIAL VEHICLE ZONES

| <u>Street</u> | <u>From</u> | <u>To</u> | <u>Side of Street</u> |

| Lincoln Street | Third Street | 130' South of Third Street | West |

SECTION XI. Section 15.32.150 Schedule S shall be amended to add the following:

HANDICAPPED PARKING


People's Park -- the first space east of Dunn Street on the north side of Fifth Street (Kirkwood Avenue)

508 N. Morton Street -- the last angle space north of Ninth Street on the east side of Morton Street

John F. Kennedy Law Enforcement Building -- the first space south of the driveway on the west side of Lincoln Street.


SECTION XII. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




