TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" (Regarding Stop and Yield Intersections; Limited, Angle, and No Parking Zones; Loading Zones; and, Handicapped Parking Spaces)
