

ORDINANCE 96-01

**TO AMEND CHAPTER 2.17 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE
ENTITLED "BOARD OF PUBLIC SAFETY"
(Expanding the Board to Five Members)**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §36-4-9-5 and Bloomington Municipal Code §2.17 establish a Board of Public Safety under the executive branch of the City; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 317 - 1995 amended Indiana Code §36-4-9-6(d) to permit the expansion of a Board of Public Safety to five (5) members;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Chapter 2.17.010 of the Bloomington Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

2.17.010 Appointments. The Board shall consist of five members who shall be appointed by the Mayor and who shall serve at the Mayor's pleasure. Members shall have been voters of the City for at least one year immediately preceding the appointment.


SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




